You'll be schooled in the art of Punting, Cambridge City and a College walking tour. Further studies will include driving tours and a visit to the Imperial War Museum Duxford Royal Air Force base. All participants will graduate in style having driven by Studebaker in the Cambridge countryside. We look forward to welcoming you to the Class of 2025.

The host hotel is from the 16th Century and is a fully working Cambridge University Hall of residence. Accommodation is a little different than a standard hotel.
